- Check your page order
  - Title Page, Copyright, Dedication, Blank, Table of Contents, Blank, YOUR BOOK, Extra Pages (Timeline, Glossary, About the Author)

## Save your book as a pdf

- Open pdf and go over it page by page
- Make sure it looks exactly the way you want it to look
- Check images to make sure they are not blurry
- The published book will look exactly the same as your file





Play around with Background, Layouts, and Themes until you find what you like


\*Background and Theme won't matter if you are importing a photo for your cover

Importing a Cover - Do you want one or two pictures?

- One This is if you want the front and back cover to be the same picture, with half on the front and the other half on the back. You will need a high resolution horizontal picture.
- One This is if you want a picture only for the front cover. You will need a high resolution vertical image.
- Two This is if you want separate pictures for the front and back covers. You will need 2 high resolution vertical images.









Next, I dragged the image within each cover in order to make it look like one photo split in the middle at the binding












Click on your title - this will cause it to zoom in
